TOUR ITINERARY

Day 1: 11 Apr 2020 – Arrive Tokyo

Upon arrival at Tokyo, meet your English-speaking assistant and transfer to the hotel. No Early check in provided.

Meals: None

Accommodation: Keio Plaza Hotel – confirmed

Day 2: 12 Apr 2020 – Tokyo

This morning, head to **Tsukiji Fish market (outer market)**, **experience sushi making** before tuck in the sushi for your lunch. Then head to **Imperial Palace** before wander through the district of Asakusa for an opportunity to pick up some souvenirs on **Nakamise Shopping street** and visit **Sensoji Temple**.

Optional: Watch Robot Show

Meals: Breakfast and Lunch (Sushi)

Accommodation: Keio Plaza Hotel – confirmed

Day 3: 13 Apr 2020 – Tokyo

Today will visit **Yoyogi Park or Shinjuku Gyoen** for cherry blossom viewing, then head to **Meiji Shrine and Harajuku** (Omotesando street), stop at the famous “**Shibuya Crossing**” for photos and last stop is **Meguro river** for another spot for cherry blossom viewing.

Optional : Taiko Drumming

Meals: Breakfast and Lunch

Accommodation: Keio Plaza Hotel – confirmed

Day 4: 14 Apr 2020 – Tokyo – Mt Fuji / Hakone

*Luggage will be transferred to Kyoto separately

*Prepare overnight bag for 1N at Mt Fuji

After breakfast and check out the hotel, transfer to Mt Fuji/Hakone, on arrival visit Mt Fuji **Shibazakura Festival** (subject to confirmation) and in the afternoon visit **Kubota Itchiku Art museum** to view the elaborate dyed silk creations and spend some time strolling around the beautiful garden.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

Accommodation: Fuji Marriott Lake Yamanaka – confirmed

Day 5: 15 Apr 2020 – Mt Fuji – Kyoto

In the morning after breakfast and check out the hotel, enjoy the **soba noodle making** before transfer to **Nemba Iyashino sato**, a former farming village on the shores of Lake Saiko. Destroyed by a landslide in 1966, the remaining thatched-roofed of this old village have been transformed into an open – air museum and craft village. Then **Mt Kachi – Kachi** ropeway before transfer to station for the bullet train to Kyoto.

Meals: Breakfast and Lunch (Soba Noodle)

Accommodation: Hotel Monterey Kyoto – confirmed

Day 6: 16 Apr 2020 – Kyoto

Today after breakfast visit **Philosopher walk**, then continue **Kiyomizu Temple and Higashiyama district**. In the afternoon visit **Kinkakuji** known as “Golden Pavillion” and enjoy the **tea ceremony experience with Maiko or Geisha**.

Optional: Kimono or Yukata wear experience

Meals: Breakfast and Lunch

Accommodation: Hotel Monterey Kyoto – confirmed

Day 7: 17 Apr 2020 – Kyoto

This morning head to **Fushimi Inari Shrine and visit Gekkeikan Sake Museum with sake tasting**, in the afternoon visit **Ryoanji Temple** home to Japan's most famous Zen Garden. Last stop is Arashiyama district, first stop is **Bamboo forest and Togetsukyo bridge**

Meals: Breakfast and Lunch

Accommodation: Hotel Monterey Kyoto – confirmed

Day 8: 18 Apr 2020 – Kyoto – Hiroshima

Luggage will be transferred to Osaka separately and have overnight bag for 1N at Hiroshima

After breakfast and check out the hotel. Walk to station for the bullet train to Hiroshima. Hiroshima will be forever remembered as the world's first atomic bomb target. Travel by coach to the famous **Peace Memorial Park and Museum**. Please be aware that the museum may be confronting and upsetting for some group members and it is at your discretion if you wish to visit or enjoy time at leisure exploring the Peace Memorial Park. Enjoy the **Okonomiyaki cooking class**, then transfer to the pier and take a short ferry ride to Miyajima Island, where sightseeing will be at a leisurely pace on foot. Visit **Itsukushima Shrine** and explore the traditional market town at leisure.

Optional: Ropeway to Mt Misen

Meals: Breakfast and Lunch (Okonomiyaki)

Accommodation: Sheraton Grand Hiroshima – confirmed

Day 9: 19 Apr 2020 – Hiroshima – Himeji – Osaka

After breakfast and check out the hotel, transfer to Himeji. On arrival, enjoy lunch at a local restaurant before visiting the beautiful **Himeji Castle and Koko-en Garden**. Himeji Castle is largely in its original condition so, please be mindful of your step when walking around. You will have to remove your shoes before walking along some of the wooden floors and there are some steep wooden steps to reach certain areas. After the reopening in March 2015, Himeji Castle

has welcomed a large number of visitors. As such, they now issue numbered tickets to enter the Main Keep in order to limit the number of people who can enter, reducing congestion, waiting time and to protect the cultural properties. Please note this means that there may be cases where some visitors are not allowed to enter the Main Keep, however, there are many other parts of the castle to explore.

Meals: Breakfast and Lunch

Accommodation: Hotel Granvia Osaka – confirmed

Day 10: 20 Apr 2020 – Depart Osaka

After breakfast and check out the hotel. Transfer to Kansai airport for your flight.

- All bookings will be held directly by Japan Airlines. Wendy Wu Tours will not have control of each booking; subsequently any changes will be made through Japan Airlines.
- **Passport bio pages will be required by Wendy Wu Tours and Japan Airlines no later than 90 days prior to departure. A deposit of \$150.00 per person will due 60 days after confirmation. This deposit is additional to Wendy Wu Tours deposit of \$300.00 per person. All deposit amounts will be non-refundable.**
- This group allotment is based on 10 passengers travelling together. If the minimum number of passengers is not reached, we will need to requote the full itinerary including the airfares. Depending on the passenger numbers confirmed Wendy Wu tours may need to hold and confirm flights in our computer reservation system as per normal.
